PCAOB history

- Created by Sarbanes-Oxley Act in 2002 in response to increasing restatements in 1990's, high-profile accounting scandals, the demise of Arthur Andersen, and record-setting bankruptcies by large public companies.
- Five Board members appointed by the SEC, two must be CPAs
