COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This dynamic 1-day workshop is essential for anyone who is involved in wound management. The course will focus on the types of wounds commonly treated in outpatient clinic settings by OTs and PTs. Participants will receive an anatomy, physiology, and pathophysiology review and will learn wound assessment and measurement techniques. Participants will participate in hands-on wound care labs focusing on treatment strategies, cleansing techniques, measurement principals, selective and nonselective debridement and the application of various wound dressings. Current standards in documentation and billing standards will also be discussed.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Demonstrate understanding of assessment of stages of wound healing
- Identify factors which may be impairing the healing process
- Demonstrate understanding of appropriate wound cleansing and measurement
- Demonstrate understanding and competency in performing non-selective and selective debridement
- Identify qualities and properties of various wound dressings to determine appropriate use
- Generate an increased level of understanding of appropriate documentation and coding as it applies to wound assessment and billing

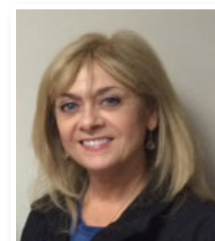
