



Sullivan Spaights Scholarship

The UWM Foundation is pleased to encourage students in their educational endeavors through the Sullivan Spaights Scholarship. This scholarship, made possible through a generous gift from Bader Philanthropies, will provide **\$8,000 for the 2018-2019 academic year** to be used for tuition and other educational expenses. Scholarships may be renewed annually for up to three additional years provided the recipient maintains full-time enrollment as an undergraduate and meets the other conditions of the award. *Spring semester grades will be reviewed as part of the application screening process.*

Amount of Award: Up to **six** scholarships valued at \$8,000 (\$4,000 per semester)

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Graduate of a Milwaukee Public High School.
2. Undergraduate status, with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher.
3. Demonstrated financial need. Filing of the 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by this application's due date is recommended if not already completed.
4. Demonstrated community leadership.
5. Member of one of the following under-represented ethnic groups: American Indian or Alaska Native, African American or Black, Hispanic or Latino/a, or Hmong/Southeast Asian.
6. Full-time enrollment (12 or more undergraduate credits during each semester).
