



Summary: Off-Campus Shuttles will be operated on an on-demand basis with UWM minivans. The Off-Campus shuttle operations will be ready to go Wednesday, September 2nd. The Housing and BOSS operations are not affected by this change.

How does it work?

The system is designed to transport faculty, staff and students to and from UWM's Milwaukee campuses. The locations serviced are Kenwood Campus, University Services and Research (USR), MATC, Zilber School of Public Health, Freshwater Science, Global Water Center and the Innovation Campus.

Users that need to move to and from those locations will be able to call **(414)-229-7431** to request a shuttle. During the call you will be asked your current location and desired destination. During peak times we will have 3 vehicles shuttling between locations. Wait times are estimated to be at or below what the wait time was with the previous shuttle bus system. To ensure response times are kept as low as possible, the vehicles will only be able to shuttle between the locations specified above. Any deviation from those locations would increase wait times for everyone in the system. The main variable in regard to wait times will be demand, traffic, weather and construction.

Notes:

- Transportation to Kenilworth will be provided by the UPARK shuttle (school bus).

- _The system will run during the academic year Monday-Friday.

- If the University cancels classes due to weather (specifically snow, not necessarily cold) we will suspend shuttle service.

- The system will not be able to transport any hazardous materials, oversized items or weapons.

- Each minivan can hold a maximum of 6 riders.

- Innovation campus service will be on request 3 times per day (8 am, 12pm, and 5 pm). Users that need to go to or from Innovation should call in prior to those times to request a ride.

- To accommodate evening classes, Zilber and Freshwater service will run until the conclusion of the last class of the day.
