Program to Program Articulation Agreement

WCTC Degree: Associate in Applied Sciences (AAS) Graphic Design

Peck School of the Arts (PSOA) at UWM: Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Design Studies

Effective Date: Fall 2015

Review Date: Fall 2020

Rationale:

Through completion of the technical courses and general education courses taken while at WCTC, students who earn the AAS degree in Graphic Design are prepared for advanced-level design work at UWM. Students completing the BA in Design Studies at UWM will have the opportunity to apply their technical knowledge to design problems that require research, conceptualization and application of ideas and formal skills to identifying and solving design problems. UWM also offers them a wide range of electives throughout the University that will inform their design experiences in the classroom.

Requirements:

Students must meet all minimum UWM transfer admission requirements. See transfer.uwm.edu for details.

WCTC students who have successfully completed the AAS in Graphic Design degree will be granted junior status in the UWM PSOA A&D BA in Design Studies program.

Students enrolled in the BA in Design Studies program must have their own laptop.

To be admitted to the program students must have a cumulative 2.5 GPA from WCTC and need to complete the Oral and Written Communication, Part A (801-136) and Quantitative Literacy, Part A (804-118) competency requirements for UWM while at WCTC. It's advisable that students also complete the Social Sciences requirements as part of their WCTC Graphic Design Associate Degree. Students should select from approved GER courses (SS). Students can complete the UWM Foreign Language proficiency requirement prior to admission by taking 2 years of the same Foreign Language in High School, or may satisfy this requirement by taking 2 semesters of the same Foreign Language at UWM. WCTC students will enter the Department of Art & Design with up to 67 credits, and will take 56 credits minimum to complete the BA in Design Studies.

Program-to-Program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the program/degree specified in this agreement. A change of major/degree/program invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within other Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement for a different major/degree/program at UWM.

WCTC/UWM Course Equivalencies:

Students earning the Associate Degree in Graphic Design from WCTC will be able to transfer the credits listed in Table 1 toward the Bachelor of Arts in Design Studies in the Peck School of the Arts at University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee (UWM).

Additional courses will transfer per established equivalencies noted on the UW System Transfer Information System (<https://www.wisconsin.edu/transfer/wizards/>).
