

MOTION

From the Senate Subcommittee on the Evaluation of Administrators (SSEA) that the Faculty Senate of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee requests from the Attorney General an opinion concerning the following:

1. Does the faculty of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee have the legal authority to evaluate the Chancellor, pursuant to the attached policy (copy of 2137 was distributed to the Senate prior to the 3/27 Senate meeting);
2. Is the use of survey instruments, including but not limited to questionnaires or other evaluation databases that are subject to public disclosure, legally permissible;
3. To what legal liability, if any, does the faculty subject itself in the evaluation of our Chancellor pursuant to Faculty Document 2137, amended 11/25/99.

RATIONALE

Pursuant to conversations in the Faculty Senate and April 1, 2003 discussion between the SSEA and the UC, the above motion is submitted.
