1. I understand participation in the UWM TRIO SSS project is subject to meeting federal grant eligibility requirements and approval by the school/college that admitted me to UWM.
2. I understand I will have an assigned Student Support Services Program (SSS) academic advisor as the lead advisor for approximately the first three semesters of my education at UWM. A secondary academic advisor may be assigned based upon the intended major.
3. I understand SSS uses a proactive approach to academic advising with each advisor having an average of 125 students. SSS participation will enable me build relationships by spending more one-on-one time with SSS staff, using the SSS computer lab in Mitchell Hall 135 that includes access to free printing, potential eligibility for Supplemental Grant Aid awarded spring semester, and to borrow a laptop on a short term basis free of charge.
4. If at all possible, I will attend the four-weeks SSS Summer Bridge Program in its entirety. If unable to do so, I understand that I am required to meet with my SSS advisor bi-weekly during my first semester at UWM and take Economics 110 (Personal Finance) during my first semester.
