This document outlines the purpose, charge, and other details regarding a work group to identify recommended directions or alternative ways to meet the key issues outlined in the resolution passed on April 12, 2023, by the Washington County Board of Supervisors to merge UWM at Washington County with the Moraine Park Technical College – West Bend campus into a community college ("the resolution").

Charge

The UWM at Washington County Work Group will examine possible options in response to the resolution and make recommendations about how UWM should communicate with its stakeholders on these issues (e.g., what modes of communication, frequency, etc.).

The work group will offer written recommendations to the executive sponsors on or before Sept. 1, 2023, noting that recommendations will be based on the UWM at Washington County's existing budget and address possible future budget decreases if UW at Washington County's enrollments further decline.
