## Undergraduate Student

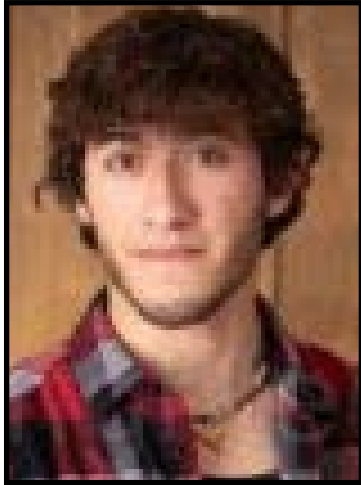
### Tia Purcell
