Object-based attention (OBA) refers to enhanced processing within an attended object compared to unattended objects<sup>1</sup>

Faster performance along horizontal meridian than vertical meridian<sup>2</sup>, called the **shift direction anisotropy (SDA)**<sup>3,4</sup>, which is modulated by visual field quadrant<sup>5</sup>

Enhancing the perceptual visibility of horizontal meridian with a visible line eliminates the SDA; meridians with an illusory contour had no effect<sup>6</sup>

Is elimination of the SDA vary by visual field quadrant?

Experiment 1: Visible Meridians (N=28)

Experiment 2: Illusory Meridians (N=28)
