ENG 100 (4cr.)

Credit-bearing course for developmental college writers, fully equivalent to ENG 101 (same curriculum, required text, etc.). Small class sizes (12-15), expert teachers who receive extra training and support. Meets 4 hours per week, plus 3 required visits to the writing center (additional visits recommended).

ENG 101 (3cr.)

Most students will place into this class. 101 is focused on rhetoric and rhetorical awareness. It prepares students to think rhetorically about research in 102. Standard curriculum, same required textbook (*Panther Guide to First-Year Writing*), four major papers.

ENG 102 (3cr.)

Brand-new research-intensive course that builds on rhetorical knowledge from 101 and adds information literacy concepts. Prepares students to tackle complex research problems and use more sophisticated research strategies in other courses. Standard curriculum, same required text (online, interactive learning tool), four major papers/projects.
