What are virtual opportunities?

Online experiences that can serve as a global foundation.

The format of virtual programs vary.

- Hybrid combining any number of educational experiences into one program
- Primarily online and include an in-person trip towards the end of the program
- Others may be entirely virtual and combine courses with hands-on remote internships
- Some programs will be conducted (or partially conducted) in a foreign language while others will be in English

What are the benefits of a virtual international education experience?

- Fosters global, cross-cultural engagement when physical travel is not an option.
- Serves as an influential experience to build students' skills, résumé, and cross-cultural understanding. This can also be a great foundation for future on-site international experiences.
- With a virtual internship, students will work on projects for an international organization from their home base in the U.S. while adding a global perspective to their professional work experience.
- It's cost effective, flexible, accessible, fun and a gateway to other adventures.
