#### When should I apply?

- Many schools open applications a year prior to the intended start date.
- What is the application deadline?
- Are any standardized tests required?



#### Does your current university offer accelerated degrees?


#### **HOW IT WORKS**

#### Most programs require that students:

- Indicate their intention to pursue an accelerated master's
- Meet minimum requirements, such as GPA and prerequisites
- Complete most general education requirements prior to graduate work
- Enroll in designated graduate courses that count toward both the undergraduate and graduate degrees.
- · Apply early for Graduate School
- Complete required coursework to finish both undergraduate and graduate degrees

Each Accelerated Master's Degree pairs a single undergraduate degree with a single graduate degree.

Eligibility and application procedures differ. See program for details.

# What does the application process look like?

#### Requirements for every UWM applicant:

- Application UWM uses Panthera
- Application Fee UWM is \$75 for Master's and PhD programs
- Transcripts Unofficial vs. Official
- English Proficiency If English is not your first language
- Reason Statement





# What does the application process look like?

#### Requirements determined by programs:

- Standardized Tests
- Letters of Recommendation
- Writing Sample
- Portfolio
- Audition
- Resumé
- Other Field-Related Materials





#### When will you receive a decision?

#### This depends on:


- How the program chooses to review applications
- How far in advance you submitted your

application





## What funding is available to Master's and Doctoral students?





#### **Assistantships**

Approximately ¼ of the more than 5,000 master's and doctoral students receive one the of the following assistantships:

- Teaching Assistantship
- Project Assistantship
- Research Assistantship

Assistantships generally cover tuition, health care costs and support full-time students.





#### **Fellowships**

The Graduate School supports and administers five intramural fellowship programs for master's and doctoral students:

- Distinguished Graduate Student Fellows
- Doctoral Dissertator Fellows
- Advanced Opportunity Program Fellows
- Chancellor Graduate Awards Fellows
- Research Excellence Awards Fellows

#### And philanthropic fellowships:

- Graduate Student Excellence Fellows
- Levine Science Fellows
- Other Fellowships May Be Available





#### **Fellowships**


Many fellowships include the following benefits:
