Panther's Vote Goals

- Boost faculty involvement in campus voting initiatives.
- Increase voter turnout to 60% of the eligible student population in the 2022 midterms.
- Raise voting rates in departments with low rates of voting turnout to 55% or higher in the 2022 fall election (fields of study rates needing a boost listed below).
 - Engineering & Engineering Technologies 46%
 - Physical Sciences 43%
 - Social Sciences 51%
 - Mathematics and Statistics 51%
 - Computer and Information Sciences 51%
 - Biological and Biomedical Sciences 51%

Action Items to Help us Achieve These Goals
