Chemistry Placement Information

- Chemistry placement will be based on a combination of math placement level and performance in high school chemistry. Advisors will assess and use course permission to enroll students.
 - o If the student has a level 20 or higher math placement or has MATH 105 course or equivalent, then check for HS chemistry coursework and grade
 - Grade of B or higher, advise them to take CHEM 101, 102, 105 but give them the option to take CHEM 100 if they are concerned about their chemistry preparation (some might opt to do this).
 - Grade of B- or lower, advise them to take CHEM 100.
 - o If the student placed lower than 20 or did not complete MATH 105 course or equivalent, then check for HS chemistry coursework and grade.
 - Grade of B or higher, advise them to take CHEM 101, 102, 105 but give them the option to take CHEM 100 if they are concerned about their chemistry preparation (some might opt to do this); CHEM 101, 102, 105 would be taken once MATH 105 is passed. CHEM 100 could be taken Fall semester as it is coreq'd with MATH 105.
 - Grade of B- or lower, advise them to take CHEM 100 concurrently with MATH 105.
- Chemistry 102 Students in Chemistry 102 will be required to take a chemistry placement test the first week of class during their chemistry class to determine if their current enrollment is the best fit. They may need to switch their chemistry course depending on their placement test results.

World Language Placement Information

- Placement in French, German, and Spanish is based on the UW System World Languages Placement Tests administered between 03/01/2022-02/28/2023. Placement milestones are assigned in PAWS.
- Placement in all other languages is based on recommendations from previous coursework/language experience and performance on the UWM World Languages Self-Assessment Tool. Milestones are not generated from the self-assessment; students are emailed a course recommendation. Advisors use course permission when necessary to enroll students.
- Foreign language GER satisfaction is not awarded via the UW System Placement or UWM self-assessment. Students must work directly with the language department and the Registrar's Office to determine what steps can be taken to satisfy GER for those with sufficient language knowledge.
