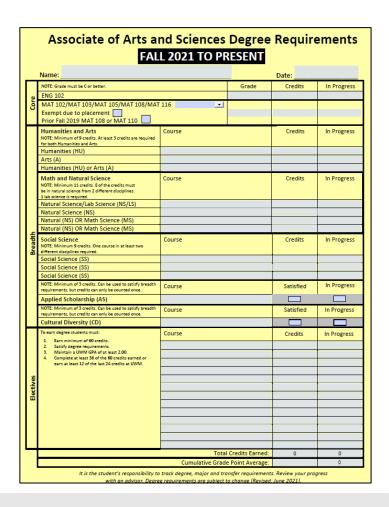


Eligibility

- CGS Advisor Will update student and Assigned Advisor

 - Student must notify CGS Advisor upon completion
 - CGS Advisor may request syllabus/course description of class meeting potential requirements
 - 3) If approved, student must apply for graduation
