# UW-Milwaukee Foundation Admission for International Students

***1. Eligible for full admission***

***2. Eligible for full admission with academic foundation program requirements***

***3. Eligible for admission via the intensive English program***





# UW-Milwaukee Foundation Admission for International Students

- **Category 1 – Eligible for full admission:** Students in this category may enroll in full-time academic coursework.

<b>TOEFL</b>	79
<b>IELTS</b>	6.5



# UW-Milwaukee Foundation Admission for International Students

- **Category 3 – Eligible for admission via intensive English program:** Prior to being able to enroll in any academic (credit-bearing) coursework, these students will be required to complete English language training. Students whose performance in this English language training indicates that they are at least able to perform at the Category 2 level above will be allowed to begin the foundational program, also outlined above.

<b>TOEFL</b>	<65
<b>IELTS</b>	<5.0





# UW-Milwaukee Foundation Admission for International Students

- **Category 2 – Eligible for full admission via academic foundation:** Students in this category will be required to complete a foundational program. This foundational program will allow students to enroll in academic courses. These students will also enroll in English for Academic Purposes (EAP) courses that match their individual needs. Based on their performance, these students will progress toward category 1.

<b>TOEFL</b>	65-78
<b>IELTS</b>	5.0-6.0

These three courses belong to a sequence that culminates in the campus GER composition requirement, English 102).</li> <li>• <b>Maximum non-foundational credits:</b> 12</li> <li>• <b>Maximum total credits:</b> 16</li> </ul>

74-78/6.0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Required foundational coursework:</b> One of EAP 110, 100 or 101 (3-4 credits — placement determined upon arrival at UWM. These three courses belong to a sequence that culminates in the campus GER composition requirement, English 102).</li><li>• <b>Maximum non-foundational credits:</b> 12</li><li>• <b>Maximum total credits:</b> 16</li></ul>



# UW-Milwaukee Foundation Admission for International Students

## Summary:

- Though TOEFL/IELTS scores have changed, the basic categories of "Conditional Admission" and "Full Admission" remain the same.
- Dual admission has been replaced by "Admission with required foundational coursework."
- Required foundational coursework for Fall 2019 will include 3-semester, 2-semester and 1-semester programs, depending on scores on TOEFL and IELTS.
- Required foundational coursework will be revisited regularly by CIE and EAP, to determine changes to the implementation of this admission category.
