More Changes for Math at UWM?



College-level courses

- We will continue to offer Math 103 and Math 105 as we do now for students who place into these courses.
- We will offer Math 102 and Math 108 as we do now.

New Math 075 course

- A one-credit (financial aide only) review for students who want to try to improve placement level
 - Targeting Placement Level 10 (e.g. Math 098) and trying to get up to Placement Level 20 (e.g. into Math 105)
 - Work on ALEKS PPL
 - Meet in-person to discuss study skills, complete worksheets, get help on ALEKS topics, etc.

Already Ahead in System

- Pathways approach:
 - Math Literacy Pathway (092/102)
 - Algebra Pathway (098/108)
- Co-requisite option:
 - Students needing developmental mathematics can concurrently enroll in 10x course and the 09x course
- Finding success so it's working!

Eliminating all standalone developmental math courses ????

- Current trend nationwide
- No Math 092 nor Math 098 courses all students needing these would take coreq

Math 098/108 imbalance

- Need to balance enrollments and staffing for Math 098/108 Corequisite between fall and spring semesters
- All Math 098/108 can't fit in fall

Math 098/108 imbalance

- Offering lots of sections of Math 075 for students to work on improving placement level out of dev math (so could take Math 105 or even Math 103)
 - Anyone with placement level 10 that can't get into Math 098/108 in fall
 - Anyone who is "nearly" undecided, or not 231 intended

What does this mean for students?

If no Math 092 nor Math 098 courses ...

- What if a student doesn't pass the coreq (Math 09x) part of the course?
 - Retake entire coreq
- What if a student passes the coreq (Math 09x) part of the course but not the college level-part (Math 10x)?
 - Standalone college-level (Math 10x) courses will remain

What about Math 094?

- Currently lowest math level students take ...
 - Math 094 if they know they need more math or science work
 - Math 092 if they do NOT (this includes undecided students!)

If we eliminate Math 094 ...

- ... then ALL lowest level math students would take Math 092+102 Corequisite
- Planning to take more math or science work? Then take Math 092+102 Corequisite in the fall semester PLUS Math 075 to review any topics needed to go into Math 105
- Student who are NOT? Then take Math 092+102 in the spring (like now)

Pros and Cons

- Pro for students: Instead of taking Math 094, these students would get three credits towards graduation and QLA in first semester and still take Math 105 in spring (as they do now)
- Con for students: Instead of taking Math 094 (equivalent of six credits), they would take Math 092+102 Corequisite PLUS Math 075 for equivalent of seven credits (three towards graduation and four for financial aide)

Who takes Math 092+102 & when?

Fall Semester	Spring Semester
Math 092+102 Corequisite PLUS Math 075 (for students needing Math 105)	Math 105
(no math)	Math 092+102 Corequisite (for students only needing QLA)

Course Summary (AY 20-21)

Piloting Math 092+102 versus Math 094 (seeking IRB approval for research study)

- Fall 2020
 - 3 sections of Math 094 running as they do now
 - 4 sections of Math 092+102
 - Students will also be required to take Math 075
 - By consent only need to limit to students needing
 Math 105 in the spring (STEM, Nursing, Business, etc.)
- Spring 2021
 - We will see how these students all do in Math 105!

Online Dev Math (AY 20-21)

No online offering for Math 094, but...

- Summer 2020
 - Piloting completely online version of Math 092+102
 Corequisite (materials will be free since pilot)
- Fall 2020
 - Offering completely online version of Math 092+102
 Corequisite WITH a paired online version of Math 075 for these students

NOTE: Math 098+108 Corequisite still pretty new so online option not available until Fall 2021 (earliest)

Math 103 for AY 20-21

We will offer one large lecture of Math 103 for fall (previously fall was only offered online).

Math 116/117 for AY 20-21

- We will no longer offer Math 116/117, beginning Fall 2020.
- Instead, students will take Math 115 (all placement level 3x).

We will be back in March!

At the March ACN meeting, we will discuss more about students who don't pass.

For instance:

- What does a D in Math 094 mean?
- What if a student needs permission to repeat a second time (third attempt)?
- Revisit coreq passing: such as what if a student passes Math 098, but not Math 108 in the Math 098+108 coreq?
