
# Wisconsin Tuition Promise Program

## Eligibility

- Wisconsin resident for tuition purposes
- First time full-time freshman or transfer undergraduate starting fall 2023
- Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) per Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) below \$62,000
  - Dependent students, looks at parent AGI
  - Independent students, includes student and spouse AGI (if married)
- Meets all Title IV eligibility requirements
- Employed in preceding twelve months

### Continued Eligibility

- Completes FAFSA is subsequent years
- Meets all Title IV eligibility requirements including maintaining satisfactory academic progress (SAP)
- Continuously enrolled (excludes winter and summer terms)
- Four years of eligibility (two years transfers)
