Tia Richardson is a Milwaukee-based community mural artist who has completed 50 collaborative murals in partnership with schools and universities, community centers and public spaces in Milwaukee and beyond. Themes in her work have ranged from education, positive self-esteem, hopes and dreams, community empowerment, social issues to character-building. In 2018, she was named Artist of the Year by the Milwaukee Arts Board. Tia is a graduate of Milwaukee High School of the Arts, holds a degree in graphic design from Milwaukee Area Technical College and is certified in trauma-informed care from First Aid Arts.
