

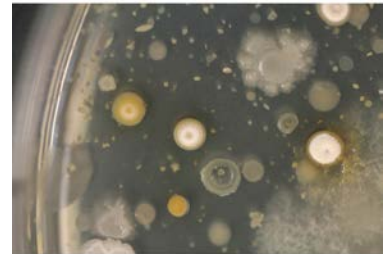
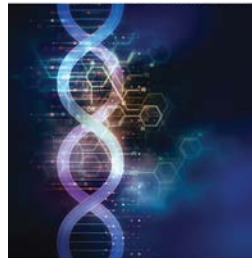
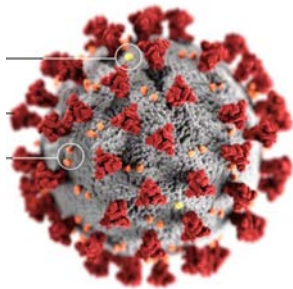

Requires BioSci 152 (prerequisite – C or better)  
BioSci 325 (prerequisite or concurrent registration)
