MASTER OF SCIENCE IN MANAGEMENT

The program provides students with foundational training in disciplines including accounting and statistical analysis. Students then gain in-depth finance skill sets necessary to understand and meet the growing needs of financial industries and gain preparation necessary for the Chartered Financial Analyst exams (CFA).
