Answers to Common MBA/MSITM Program Questions

- Advanced Standing (AS) is given to foundation course work with UWM equivalent coursework in Business Math and Financial Accounting
- Foundation coursework is not required prior to admission
- If not given "AS", foundation coursework is required in addition to the MBA requirement.
- 33-credits are required to complete the MBA, but double count with MSITM courses. Credits are based on the approved Lubar College of Business MBA Curriculum.
- In the MSITM/MBA Program, "AS" cannot be given to more the 1 MBA Core Courses and is determined by your Undergraduate Degree, not on Undergraduate courses.
- All MBA Electives are 3 credits, unless otherwise noted (Example: "BA 715 (2)")
