ONLINE GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN

HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT

Managers within the health care industry need to be able to understand and address unique industry-specific topics, ranging from delivery systems and integrated health care networks, to specialized accounting, legal, and ethical issues. Dig deeper into these areas through a focused set of courses in the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Management. You'll learn from a winning combination of academic faculty and experienced health care executives with deep knowledge of the industry — and alongside other professionals with similar career challenges and goals.

This program can be completed as a standalone certificate or in combination with a master's degree program.

Curriculum

Students who wish to earn a Graduate Certificate in Health Care Management must complete the required 15 graduate credit hours with an overall GPA of 3.00 or better. The curriculum consists of five required courses:

Required Core Courses (12 Credits)

BUS ADM 755 Health Care Administration and Delivery Systems

BUS ADM 757 Managed Care and Integrated Health Networks

BUS MGMT 720 Strategic Management in Health Care Organizations

BUS MGMT 727 Health Care Accounting, Law, and Ethics

Elective Courses (3 Credits)

Choose **one** from the following:

BUS ADM 731 Diversity in Organizations

BUS ADM 738 Human Resource Management

BUS ADM 759 Seminar in Health Care Management (selected topics)

BUS MGMT 715 Leadership, Teambuilding, and Effective Management

Students may enter the program in the summer, fall, or spring semester. A maximum of one three-credit course from another college or university may be considered for transfer to the Certificate program. There is a time limit of three years from initial enrollment for completion of the Certificate program.

Admission

Those who wish to enroll in the Certificate program must, at a minimum, have completed a bachelor's degree with an overall GPA of 2.75 or better. Students may apply to the Graduate School for the certificate program alone, or they may pursue the certificate in combination with the MBA program or MS in Management program at the Lubar College of Business.

Admission to the Certificate program requires transcripts before the application can be processed. Transcripts must be sent directly to the Graduate School, University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, P.O. Box 340, Milwaukee, WI 53201, from the institution. The Graduate School needs only the transcript of the highest degree earned. The application is online at graduateschool-apply. uwm.edu.
