- Online applications require:
 - (i) a letter of personal interest and
- Your cost ~ \$3,000; this includes TUITION, hotels with internet and breakfasts, required travel during the program, and a few dinners.
- EY Scholarship will help
- Your personal costs will include airfare, some meals, and any other personal items
- Limit of 25 participants





EY Accounting Study Abroad Germany 2024 - Important Dates

- September 2023 Currently accepting applications
- **February 1**st **(2024):** Application deadline, notice of acceptance or rejection shortly thereafter
- March/April (TBD): General orientation mandatory Center for International Education (CIE)
- April (TBD): <u>mandatory</u> program meeting for accepted students at UWM (syllabus provided)
- May 19th: Program begins in Stuttgart, Germany (Sunday afternoon)
- May 31st: Program ends in Berlin, Germany (Friday morning)
