You can expect the CPaRC Staff to:

- Treat your concerns and questions with regard and respect
- GUIDE you, not DECIDE for you
- Support you in your search
- Maintain your confidentiality (exceptions noted on intake questionnaire)
- Maintain a professional relationship with you and avoid development of other relationships while you remain a client

We expect that You will:

- Communicate openly and honestly with your counselor
- Remain open to possibilities your counselor poses to you
- Actively participate in the process
- Request a different counselor if yours is not helping you the way you need

We may advise you to discontinue counseling if:

- You repeatedly miss appointments or misuse the counselor's time
 - You enter the center under the influence of drugs or alcohol
 - You sexually harass or threaten a staff member, or disrespect staff or other students
 - You display disruptive behavior or ignore expressed boundaries of staff
