Chancellor Mark Mone, PhD

Mark Mone leads the largest university in southeastern Wisconsin. He was appointed Chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (UWM) in 2014. He has put UWM on a strategic course for student success, research growth, partnerships, entrepreneurship and innovation while managing unprecedented challenges facing higher education. Dr. Mone spearheaded the school's most ambitious fundraising campaign, which raised more than \$251 million.

UWM is one of America's top research universities, educating more than 26,000 students on multiple campuses with an operating budget of \$707 million. Chancellor Mone has successfully led the state's second-largest University to institute operational efficiencies, executed strategic opportunities and enrollment management plans, and improved business practices.

Dr. Mone has served higher education for more than 30 years as a faculty member, associate dean and senior administrator. He has a B.S. in Management from Central Washington University, a M.B.A. from Idaho State University, and a Ph.D. in Organizational Behavior and Organization Theory from Washington State University. Previously, he was a chef, food and beverage director, and opening assistant general manager in hospitality operations.
