Review Timeline and Deliverables (Becky F): Due December 16th (18th at the latest)

- **Meet with key stakeholders related to your initiatives;** ask them to help us identify gaps and work that is already happening; What do you need to make what you are doing more effective?
- **Complete Template for each initiative:** Will help map out timeline and implementation; make sure to note if efforts are in multiple places and who should move them forward
- **Executive Summary with 3-6 highest priorities** from what you learned (opinions/insights/areas of greatest impact/is anything important missing)

Hiring & Training: Build a culture of relational success related to hiring and student experience; invite people to come in and be part of a community. Ensuring that everyone on campus (all staff, faculty and students). Meeting with EM – also JD meet with Joan Prince, Scott Gronert, others to discuss initiatives

Dr. Prince noted that she would be connecting with Chancellor and others to ensure that we are not doubling work (RWI across other initiatives).

Affordability: Emergency grants. Open-sourced textbooks. Grants and scholarships – specifically related to need based aid. Lots of work happening and students are constantly navigating this trying to make things work – students are regularly impacted by finances and how it effects graduation rates and success.

Pre-Acceptance Pathways: K-12 outreach; summer programs; creating pathways between 2-year schools and high schools – how they connect; dual enrollment. Finding that these programs mostly exist – but are running out of funds. Group would like to see these successful programs continue – and be extended to a larger group of students; Maybe explore how these programs are not working – ask Brian Henshaw

Post Acceptance Pathways: Seeing the many ways that this work overlaps with pre-acceptance pathways, we should also meet with these groups (referenced above) together. We are working to collect and meet with people working in these initiatives – and in some cases getting conflicting ideas about what might happen next.

May want to meet with Simon Bronner and Scott Gronnert re: University College concept.
