- 1. Call to Order (12:00pm) Mark
- 2. Announcements
  - a. Kathy and Mark will update on campus roughly every two weeks
  - b. Kathy and Mark will be meeting with Chancellor Mone and Provosts Britz
    - i. Main point will be timeline and expectations
- 3. Automatic Consent
  - a. Approval of the minutes of the Oct. 29th, 2020 meeting
- 4. Discussion of ideas for advancing UWM's research activities and mission.
  - a. Overall Issues
    - i. Biggest issues are Collaborative/Team Research and Time/Workforce
    - ii. Need to open to "moonshots"
    - iii. Consider recommendations in terms of budget and anticipated benefits
  - b. Collaboration/Team Research
    - i. Collaborations on and beyond our campus
    - ii. Will need cultural openness to support and value this work
    - iii. IDEA: develop collaborations (CTSI COVID approach)
      - 1. Focus on thematic areas that cross-cut units
      - 2. Examples
        - a. Water/environment
        - b. Health/biomedical
        - c. Social/Behavioral
    - iv. IDEA: Merge at some level with other institutions (MCW, MSOE)
      - 1. Maximum: outright merger (may not be possible)
      - 2. Minumum: open up research to be barrier-free, transparent for research
    - v. IDEA: Regional alliance across the community
      - 1. Structure around community needs
  - c. Research Time and Workforce
    - i. General
      - 1. Need to get more time to conduct research/scholarship

- 2. Need to recognize that contributions will vary and some faculty will need time for specific research tasks
  - a. Forms of scholarship will vary
- 3. Various strategies in how to assemble and use a workforce
- ii. IDEA: Develop a work assignment policy that is flexible
  - 1. Needs to include minimum teaching, research and service
  - 2. Specifies benchmarks for adjustments; metrics may vary among disciplines but based upon their view of excellence
  - 3. Some faculty will teach more and some less in a given year depending upon other activities
  - 4. Set overall department-level goals subject to dean oversight
- iii. IDEA: Strengthen post-tenure review to allow meaningful evaluation of past and future contributions, and associated develop strategies
- iv. IDEA: Institute a procedure for reporting of research activity, regardless of whether needed for salary adjustments
- v. IDEA: Reduce the service load for faculty and staff
  - 1. May need to combine committees or streamline processes
- vi. IDEA: Use Teaching and Research Professor titles
  - 1. Part of a plan to recruit and develop academic staff
  - 2. Expect and reward performance
- d. Other notes
  - i. Research development needs to be a campus project: BRIDGE
    - 1. Building Research Infrastructure: Design/Growth/Engagement
  - ii. Space
    - 1. Need shared space for collaborative work
    - 2. Duration may vary: up to 1-2 years
  - iii. Equipment
    - 1. Move most equipment into shared facilities
      - a. Not under the control of one faculty member
      - b. Potential for more efficient staffing
      - c. User fees generally cover repairs and replacements but this is not the entire cost of facility

  - b. Move through key topics with invited guests
