

SCHOOL-AGE PROGRAM - SUMMER 2022

We're looking forward to a fun-filled summer at the Center!

At the UWM Children's Learning Center, we are focused on providing child-centered and developmentally appropriate programming. Children enjoy a nice blend of structured and unstructured time. The teachers plan a variety of engaging and fun learning experiences. Children can relax while curling up with a good book, express themselves through arts and crafts, challenge themselves with hands-on science and math activities and exercise their bodies in our indoor gym and on the playground. Children also have plenty of time to play, which helps them create lasting relationships with new and familiar friends.

Children will be placed in classrooms by the grade they are completing in school. Classroom and teacher assignments for the summer may be different than those during the academic year. Below is a general outline of programming available for each age group.

FIELD TRIPS:

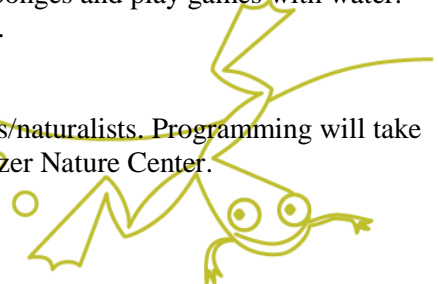

WATER FUN:

K3 + K4 children will not swim weekly at the Klotsche pool, but will get wet and have fun doing other water activities on our play yards. They will use sprinklers, spray bottles and wet sponges and play games with water. They will also enjoy zero-depth pools and other water activities on field trips.
