Before applying for the David Mulroy Scholarship for the Study of Classics Abroad, there are a number of things to consider. The scholarship, though generous, will not cover an entire study abroad program.

Here are some rough estimates for expenses:

Airfare: \$1,000-\$1,400 (this can wildly fluctuate, and may be higher or lower!)

Program Costs: \$4,500-\$10,000 (this depends on length of the program and tuition at other institutions; this typically includes lodging)

Food: \$30/day per day of your program (this could be significantly less if you have access to a kitchen in your lodging, if any meals are provided through your program, or if you're thrifty!)

CIE Administrative fee: \$500 You will work with UWM's Center for International Education, and a portion of the scholarship will be used to cover this expense.

You should also plan for personal and leisure expenses, like if you have time to travel on your own, if you want to buy souvenirs, shop, etc.

In addition to these travel expenses, you should also consider that you will still have your regular, personal expenses at home to account for (rent, car payments, etc.) in addition to the time and income you may lose at your job while you are traveling.
