Above and Beyond is modeled as an enrichment enterprise serving the public and is designed to promote personal growth and team-building through valuable mentor/student-athlete relationships working together to achieve common goals. Our mission is to create hope and opportunity for student athletes by preparing them for life beyond the game.

What We Need:

ABP is currently seeking passionate and talented instructors (Program Leader). Reporting to the Site Coordinator, Program Leaders are responsible for developing lesson plans, managing classrooms, ensuring the safety of students, and facilitating daily implementation of each program. Programs may include, but are not limited to: Sports, STEM, Coding, Cooking & Nutrition, Outdoor Education, DJ/Music Production, Dance, Photography, and Creative Arts.

What You Will Do:

Curriculum:

- Lead, implement, and instruct any curriculum provided by ABP
- Design creative and intentional activities to promote student exploration and learning
- Model and promote the mission and values of After-School All-Stars through appropriate appearance, words, and actions
- Recruit and retain a minimum of 20 students in the program
- Submit daily and weekly lesson plans

Youth Supervision:

- Under guidance of the Site Coordinator, instructors will provide direct supervision to students
- Teaching responsibilities require your presence on ABP from Monday through Thursday from 3:30pm – 6:30pm – exact time commitments and schedule to be determined.
- Using the ABP approach of positive youth discipline to help students take ownership of their actions and grow from consequences of such actions
- Travel with students for planned field trips and special events
- Maintain good order and discipline
- Ensure the school rules and policies are reflected in daily practice

Facilitation:

- Work in conjunction with the Site Coordinator and fellow Program Leaders to ensure that program activities are exciting and relevant to youth, as well as organized and well thought-out
- Maintain professional and positive relationships with school staff, partners, students, and parents
- Create and manage a caring, supportive, purposeful, and stimulating environment

Data Management:

- Take attendance regularly at the start of every class
- Maintain accurate attendance data and reports
- Submit required data on time and accurately

What You Will Need:

- The successful candidate will have a familiarity with and passion for working with underserved youth, in addition to the following:
- Some college preferred (completed or in progress)
- Ability to work cooperatively and collaboratively with school district staff, program staff, parents, and community leaders
