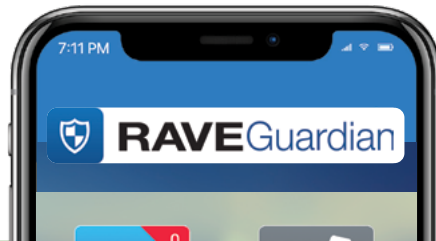

Safety - Concern

Student Support Team

SST identifies students in distress and coordinates interventions regarding:

- Severe hardship
- Mental health challenges
- Suicidal ideation

Behavioral Intervention Team (B.I.T.)

The B.I.T. acts in a proactive manner to identify, assess, manage, reduce, and educate the campus community as to the risk of potentially harmful or threatening behavior.

Timely Warning via SAFE Alerts

UWM sends safety warnings about crimes on or near campus when there is a threat to the campus community.

UWM sends emergency notifications with a description of the event and instructions to remain safe.

Transportation Safety

(Kenwood Campus)

- **Prowl Line Shuttle** transports between Milwaukee campus buildings.
- **Be On the Safe Side (BOSS)** is a safe ride service operating from 6pm–2am during the academic year.
