Service Style

The Summer Dining Services are managed by UWM Restaurant Operations. Our menus are cultivated by our CIA trained Executive Chef. Our menus utilize items grown in our own rooftop and raised bed gardens and locally sourced ingredients. The Client and their guests may utilize the Sandburg Café anytime it is open during the summer. Once in the café area guests may collect all items that they care to eat for the meal before heading out to the dining area. A typical dining experience might include 2 beverages, 1 sandwich, 1 entrée and up to 4 sides/desserts. Sides include but are not limited to bakery, fresh fruit bar, salad bar, chips, cereal and desserts. Menus will be available upon request and are subject to change. Breakfast	7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.	\$8.25 (18% discount)
Lunch	11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.	\$9.50 (14% discount)
Dinner	4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.	\$10.00 (17% discount)

Groups may choose which meals they would like to purchase during their stay. An estimated number of attendees, exact meal service periods, and days must be submitted 30 calendar days prior to arrival and a guaranteed final number 10 business day prior to first meal. Groups will be charged for the 10 business day guarantee number of meals. Groups that have additional attendees beyond our guaranteed amount will be charged full walk in rate prices. Requests that are made after 30 day period must be reviewed and confirmed by our Residential Dining Manager to ensure the group/guests can be accommodated and may be subject to walk-in rate prices. Wisconsin Sales Tax of 6.1% will be added to all meals and/or meal card charges unless group is tax exempt. Documentation of tax-exempt status must be provided to UH at least 10 business days prior to the Arrival Date.
