BACKGROUND

The award for Outstanding Women of Color in Education Award was created in 1994 to honor women of color from around the state for their leadership in making significant and lasting contributions to their campuses, their communities or both. Founded in 2008, the P.B. Poorman Award recognizes LGBTQ+ people and their allies for their important advocacy and leadership in advancing the inclusion, rights, and opportunities of LGBTQ+ people on their campuses and communities.

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR BOTH AWARDS

Successful candidates will be women of color for the Outstanding Women of Color Award and LGBTQ+ individuals or their allies for the P.B. Poorman Award whose contributions have advanced the work of diversity, equity, and Inclusive Excellence in the following ways:

- Promotion of social justice and organizational change through advocacy, activism and/or scholarship;
- Creation of positive transformation within their institutions and/or their community to achieve the goals of diversity, equity and inclusion; and
- Improvement of the climate for, or status and visibility of, either people of color or LGBTQ+ people, dependent on the award.

UWM will select one honoree for each award to be forwarded to UW System administration. A committee consisting of past recipients will review nominations and select honorees.
