## Instructions

As a student in the Computer Science Professional Master's program, it is important that you have a solid foundation in Computer Science. To ensure this, you must have demonstrated competency in the four given areas before graduation. Complete this form initially prior to registering for any courses, preferably with the help of your academic advisor. After changes (e.g., passing the sufficiency examination), complete a new copy of the form.

Please fill out this form electronically except for signatures, because this will make the form easier to read.

Each requirement can be met in a number of different ways:

- You have taken this course or an equivalent course with a sufficiently good grade (C or higher) to indicate mastery of the material. Check "PC" and give the required information. This option is not usable for CompSci 351.
- You passed the sufficiency examination (that can only be taken in your first semester). Check "SE" and give the year of the examination.
- A Computer Science professor at UWM qualified to evaluate your mastery has waived the requirement for you. You may need to take one or more examinations in order to demonstrate your mastery of the subject. Check PE and list the professor and date evaluation was done.
- You can take it while in the program. For CompSci 431G, 535G, 537G and (substituting for CompSci 351) CompSt 751, you can use the courses as part of your program. Check "MT." When you apply for graduation, we will check that you have taken and passed the course.

If your departmental admission letter mentions that you *must* take CompSci 351 or CompSci 317, then normally you should check the "Must Take" option.

## Approval

Complete this form, sign it and send it to your advisor along with a copy of all relevant transcripts. Once the advisor is satisfied, they should sign it and then send to the graduate office, typically by email to [ceas-graduate@uwm.edu](mailto:ceas-graduate@uwm.edu). The graduate office will consult with the graduate program representative (GPR) and get their approval, or refer it back to you and your advisor for correction. In any case, you will be notified of the approval decision.
