CompSci 995 Guidelines and Registration Form

Complete all documentation TWO WEEKS prior to the start of the semester stated below and submit to EMS 379.

- An MS Computer Science student cannot register for CompSci 995 on his or her own. Instead, the student must write a proposal and complete this form, and then submit the two documents to the CEAS Graduate Office. Someone in the said office will then register the student.
- A proposal must be typed and contain a detailed description of what the student plans to do. It should specify the goals of the Capstone Project, the tasks the student plans to complete and the reference materials that will be used. It should also describe how frequently the student and the supervisor plan to meet and the criteria the supervisor will use to evaluate the student. *The supervisor must sign the proposal and this registration form.*
- The CS Department considers a student to have completed CompSci 995 if (i) the student presents a poster on a Capstone Day¹ and (ii) submits a written report about the project that is approved by the supervisor to the CEAS Graduate Office.
