Instructions

As a student in the M.S. Computer Science program, it is important that you have a solid foundation in Computer Science. If you are using a non-UWM course to fulfill a requirement, make sure that you provide all the requested information (School, Course Number, etc.). If the title of the course differs substantially from that of the UWM course title, please attach an explanation as to why the non-UWM course is equivalent to the UWM course.

If you have not fulfilled a requirement, discuss with your academic advisor when you plan to take it.

Please note that at most six graduate credits used to satisfy the undergraduate requirements can be part of your program of study. (That is, at most two of CompSci 458, 535, 537 can be part of your program of study.)
