# Queering Screened Jewishness: Gendered Ethnic Performance in American Cinema

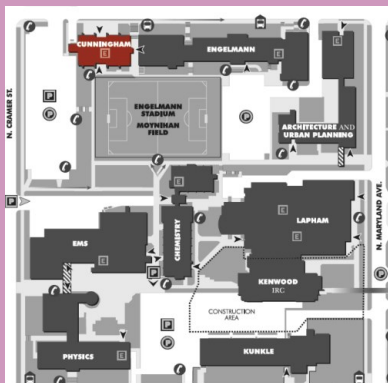
