

Enrolling for College Credit in the Natural History Workshops - Summer 2021

The workshops listed below are available for college credit. There is an **additional online component** that must be completed to receive college credit (dates are given below). To obtain college credit for the workshop, you will need to register at UWM as a non-degree student, and then enroll online through the PAWS system. You will need to pay tuition for the credits (tuition cost below), plus the workshop fee which will be billed after you establish your PAWS account and enroll in the class through PAWS. The workshop fee is discounted for students enrolling in the class for credit.
