Application Information

- Submit a UW-System Application [online](#) or [mail](#) to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, P.O. Box 413, Milwaukee, WI 53201
 - Priority Application Deadline for Fall: **July 1st**
 - Priority Application Deadline for Spring: **December 1st**
- Submit all appropriate transcripts to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, P.O. Box 749, Milwaukee, WI 53201
 - Include Official High School transcripts and/or GED/HSED score report
 - Include all post-secondary transcripts

Students who have received or will receive an Associate Degree in Graphic Design from WCTC in August 2013 or later may be able to be admitted directly into the Design Studies program at UWM. Work with a WCTC Transfer Specialist to review the following:

- Students must meet all minimum UWM transfer admission requirements. See transfer.uwm.edu for details.
- WCTC students who have successfully completed the Graphic Design AAS degree will be granted junior status in the UWM PSOA Art & Design BA in Design Studies program.
- Students enrolled in the BA in Design Studies program must have their own laptop. Visit arts.uwm.edu for more information.
- Students need a 2.5 GPA from WCTC and need to complete the prerequisite to UWC-A (801-136) and QL-A (804-118_ requirements for UWM while at WCTC.
- It is advisable that students also complete the Social Sciences requirements as part of their WCTC Graphic Design Associate Degree. Students should select from approved GER courses (SS). Students need to complete their UWM Foreign Language proficiency; 2 years of the same Foreign Language in High School, or 2 semesters of Foreign Language at UWM.
- WCTC students will enter the Department of Art & Design with up to 67 credits, and will take 56 credits minimum to complete the BA in Design Studies.
- Program-to-Program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the program/degree specified in this agreement. A change of major/degree/program invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within other Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement for a different major/degree/program at UWM.
- Articulation Art credits will only be granted for courses at WCTC in which the student earned a grade of C or better
