Students beginning at the Main Campus are reported as retained if they re-enrolled at the Main Campus, regardless of whether their major remained the same. Students beginning at the Waukesha Campus or the Washington County Campus are reported as retained if they re-enrolled at either of these branch campuses. N/A indicates no new freshmen enrollment. To help protect student privacy, beginning and retained headcounts are not reported.

²Rates reflect the percentage of fall new freshmen (full-time and part-time) with an intended or declared major who graduated with a bachelor's degree in six years or less. Students are counted with their initial field of study. Students graduating within six years are reported as graduated in the calculation of these rates, regardless of whether their major remained the same. Rates only include bachelor's degree recipients from the main campus with no prior degrees/completions from UWM (Flex degrees are excluded). N/A indicates no new freshmen enrollment. To help protect student privacy, beginning and retained headcounts are not reported.
