 - Include Official High School transcripts and/or GED/HSED score report
 - Include all post-secondary transcripts

Articulation Agreement: Program to Program Transfer Conditions from Sign Language Interpreter at NCTC to Exceptional Education - ASL at UWM

Students who have received or will receive an Associate Degree in Sign Language Interpreter in Education at NCTC after September 1, 2011 are guaranteed transferability of academic coursework as credits into the Exceptional Education – American Sign Language Program at UWM. Work with an NTC Transfer Specialist to review the following:

- The student must meet General Education Requirements and UWM Degree Requirements before receiving a Bachelor’s degree
- Course equivalencies above are subject to change in the event that the curricula of NTC or UWM undergoes revision
- A maximum total of 72 credits may be transferred from NTC to UWM
- The student must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average
- The student must have begun their Associate Degree from NTC within the last 10 years of being admitted to UWM

NTC to UWM: ASL Course Equivalencies

Coursework is transferred from the Associate Degree in Sign Language Interpreter in Education program at Northcentral Technical College to the Bachelor Degree in Exceptional Education – American Sign Language program at UWM on a case by case basis.

- Course equivalencies can be reviewed online at the UWM Transfer Equivalency Database (ted.uwm.edu) or the UW Transfer Information System (tis.uwsa.edu)
- The UWM Bachelor of Science Degree in Exceptional Education – American Sign Language requires a total of 128 degree credits; however six credits are waived for NTC's Sign Language Interpreter in Education Associate Degree graduates totaling 122 degree credits for the Bachelor of Science degree
- Students who did not complete the Associate Degree will not guaranteed transferability, but will be evaluated for transfer credits on an individual basis
