The UWM Foundation is pleased to encourage students in their academic endeavors through the following scholarship. This scholarship will be awarded to several UWM students for the 2016-2017 academic year and may be used toward the cost of full-time tuition or other educational expenses. The number of awards and dollar amounts are left to the discretion of the Scholarship Selection Committee.

Amount of Award: Minimum of **\$2,500** (\$16,300 total available)

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Female graduate student or female undergraduate student who has junior or senior standing.
2. Pursuing a degree in mathematics, engineering, computer science, computer engineering, or a (natural) science field. NOTE: this scholarship is *not intended* for students majoring in a social science or information science.
3. Cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher in prior undergraduate coursework.
4. Must be currently enrolled full-time at UWM (8 graduate credits or 12 undergraduate credits).
5. Must be a Wisconsin resident (with Wisconsin resident status for tuition purposes), and must be from Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Washington, or Waukesha county.
6. Demonstrated financial need (must have filed the 2016-2017 Free Application for Federal Student Aid by the application due date).
7. Preference will be given to U.S. citizens and eligible non-citizens.
8. Preference may be given to graduate students changing careers and/or planning to reenter the work force (if all other qualifications are equal).
