Description of Award:

John P. and Tashia F. Morgridge have generously provided for a full-tuition renewable scholarship for a June 2016 graduate from Lynde & Harry Bradley Technology & Trade High School who will be a new incoming UWM Freshman for the 2016-17 academic year. In addition please note: fall semester tuition will be disbursed in late August, with spring semester disbursement dependent upon successful completion in fall of 12 or more credits with a GPA of 3.00 or better. The scholarship is renewable annually for three additional years if the student maintains full-time status (12 or more credits) and a 3.00 cumulative GPA.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. June 2016 graduation from Lynde & Harry Bradley Technology & Trade High School
2. Accepted for admission at UWM for fall 2016
3. Demonstrated Financial need (complete FAFSA by March 1st)

Note: Application for admission to UWM must be made prior to or upon completion of scholarship application.

Required Application Materials:

1. Completed scholarship application.
2. Personal Statement: Please describe your high school achievements, extracurricular activities, educational and career objectives, and reasons for choosing to study at UWM.
3. One Letter of Recommendation: Provide a letter from your high school principal, guidance director, guidance counselor, or teacher. Your reference should endorse your application and comment on your academic performance and promise.
