Number and Value: One or two scholarships will be available; minimum of \$1,000.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Returning adult student (must be age 25 or older), with preference to female applicants.
- 2. Must have completed at least one semester at UWM (including any 2017 Spring semester courses in progress).
- 3. Cumulative UWM GPA of 3.00 or higher (after review of transcript and/or Spring 2017 grades).
- 4. Current (Spring 2017) undergraduate enrollment in 6 or more credits. Freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors may apply; preference may be given to first Bachelor's candidates.
- 5. Must be registered in an undergraduate degree program at least half-time for the upcoming (2017 fall) semester (will not graduate prior to December 2017).
- 6. Resident of Wisconsin (must have Wisconsin residency for tuition purposes).
- 7. Demonstrated financial need. Completion of the 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by this application's deadline date is recommended. FAFSA results will be reviewed as a standard determination of financial need.
