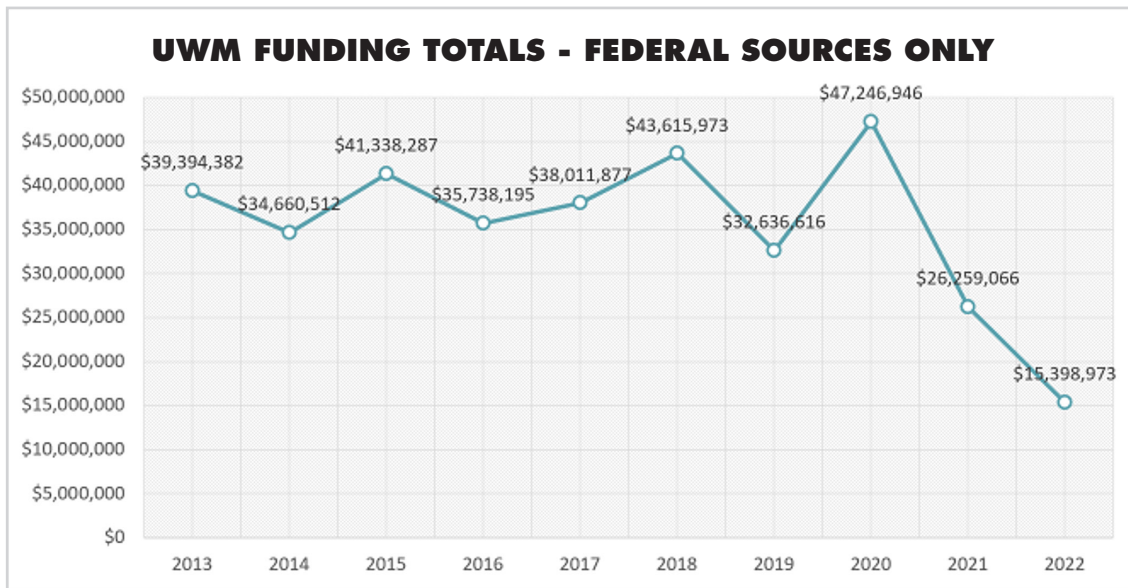


## FEDERAL RESEARCH AT UWM
