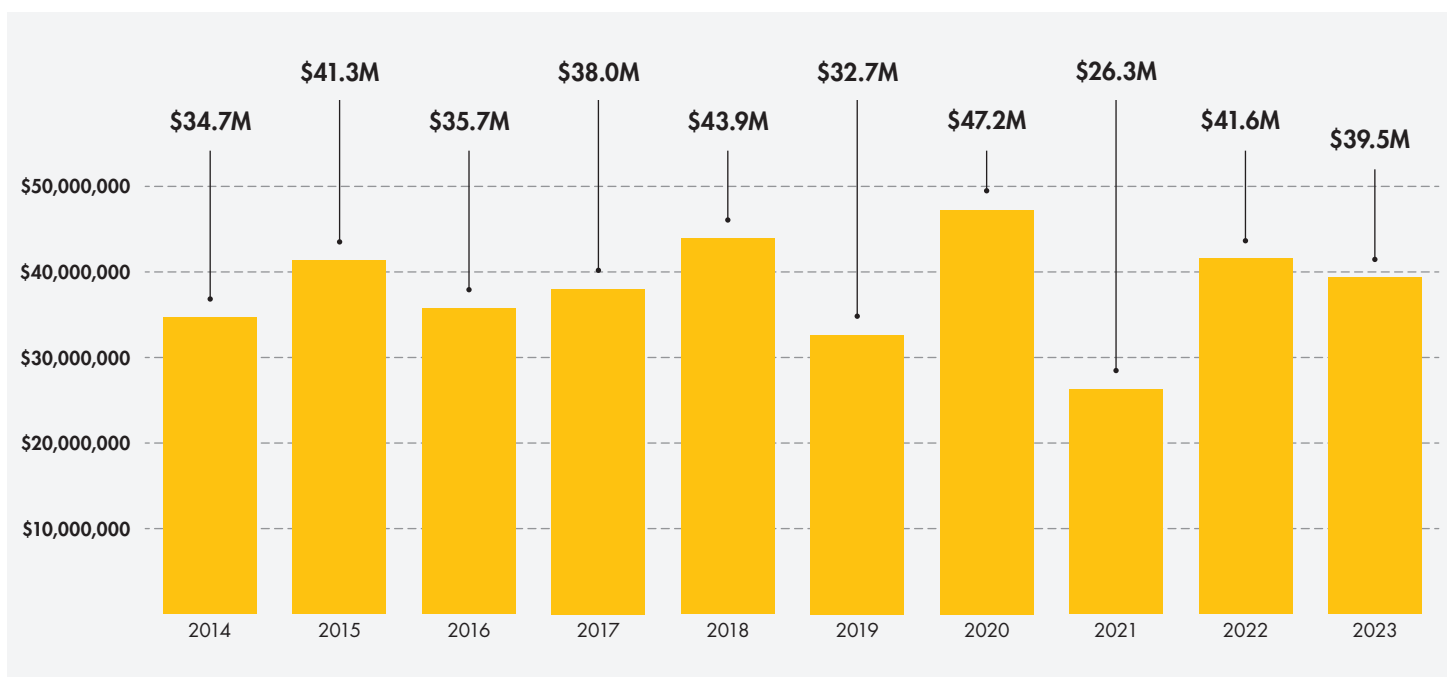




Federal Research at UWM

Since 2014, the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee has received over \$380 million in federal awards. Our faculty and staff work in conjunction with many federal partners, including the U.S. Department of Education, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Department of Energy, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and others. And for the third consecutive time, UWM has earned the highest research rating from the prestigious Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education. This Research 1 designation makes UWM part of a select group of 146 institutions out of nearly 4,000 considered.
