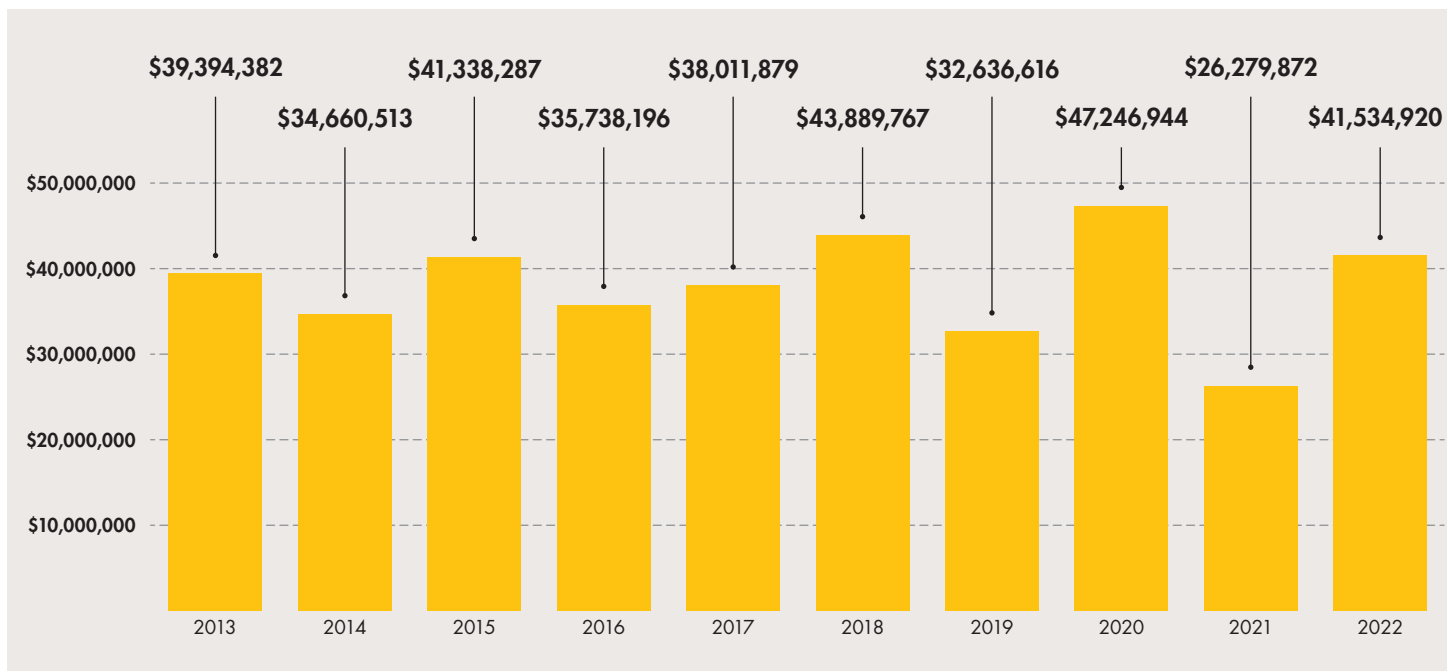


FEDERAL RESEARCH AT UWM
