

The Professor Debra Majeed Honors Scholarship

The Professor Debra Majeed Honors Scholarship was established to support students enrolled in the UWM Honors College who self-identify as members of racial or ethnic minority groups under-represented at UWM (with a preference for students who identify in whole or in part as Black or African American). The scholarship selection committee will prioritize students who graduated from Milwaukee Public Schools (with a preference for those graduating from Pulaski or Riverside High Schools) and those with demonstrated financial need.

Students admitted to the Honors College will be automatically considered for this \$1200 award (priority for incoming freshmen, but continuing students may also be considered).
